- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 49.060(a) of the Water Code is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 49.060. FEES OF OFFICE; REIMBURSEMENT. (a) A director
- 7 is entitled to receive fees of office of not more than [\$150] \$200 a
- 8 day for each day the director actually spends performing the duties
- 9 of a director. In this subsection, "performing the duties of a
- 10 director" means substantive performance of the management or
- 11 business of the district, including participation in board and
- 12 committee meetings and other activities involving the substantive
- 13 deliberation of district business and in pertinent educational
- 14 programs. The phrase does not include routine or ministerial
- 15 activities such as the execution of documents, self-preparation for
- 16 meetings, or other activities requiring a minimal amount of time.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
