## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the appointment and qualifications of bailiffs for 3 certain courts in Cameron County. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 53.001, Government Code, is amended by 5 adding Subsection (k) to read as follows: 6 7 (k) Each district court judge in Cameron County may appoint bailiffs. 8 SECTION 2. Section 53.004, Government Code, is amended by 9 adding Subsection (h) to read as follows: 10 (h) To be eligible to be appointed as a bailiff in a district 11 12 or statutory county court in Cameron County under Section 53.001(k), a person must be at least 21 years old, be of good moral 13 14 character, and hold a peace officer license issued under Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, from the Commission on Law Enforcement 15 16 Officer Standards and Education. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009. 17
