14	(3) a member or former member of the state military
15	forces, as defined by Section 431.001.
16	(b) To the extent practicable, the department shall model
17	the program established under this section after the Troops to
18	Teachers program operated by the United States Department of
19	Education and Department of Defense.
20	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
21	of this Act, the Texas Department of Criminal Justice shall
22	establish and implement a program to train and certify members and
23	former members of the military as correctional officers as required
24	by Section 493.034, Government Code, as added by this Act.
