- 3 providing penalties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 711.012(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The Texas Funeral Service Commission may enforce
- 8 Section 711.0521 and may adopt rules, establish procedures, and
- 9 prescribe forms to enforce and administer Sections 711.003,
- 10 711.008, 711.010, 711.011, 711.021-711.035, 711.038, 711.041,
- 11 711.042, 711.061, and 711.062 relating to cemeteries that are not
- 12 perpetual care cemeteries.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 711.041, Health and Safety Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 711.041. ACCESS TO CEMETERY. (a) Any person who
- 16 wishes to visit a cemetery or private burial grounds for which no
- 17 public ingress or egress is available shall have the right to
- 18 reasonable ingress and egress for the purpose of visiting the
- 19 cemetery or private burial grounds. This right of access extends
- 20 only to visitation during the [reasonable] hours determined by the
- 21 owner or owners of the lands under Subsection (b) or at a reasonable
- 22 <u>time as provided by Subsection (c)</u> and only for purposes usually
- 23 associated with cemetery visits.
- 24 (b) The owner or owners of the lands surrounding the

- 1 cemetery or private burial grounds may designate the routes of
- 2 reasonable ingress and egress and reasonable hours of availability.
- 3 (c) At a time other than the time provided by Subsection
- 4 (b), the owner or owners of the lands surrounding a cemetery or
- 5 private burial grounds must allow a person to enter and exit the
- 6 owner's land for the purpose of visiting the cemetery or private
- 7 burial grounds if:
- 8 (1) the person provides written notice to the owner or
- 9 owners of the lands surrounding the cemetery or private burial
- 10 grounds of the person's visit;
- 11 (2) the person provides the notice required by
- 12 Subdivision (1) not later than the 14th day before the date the
- 13 person wishes to visit the cemetery; and
- 14 (3) the time of the visit is reasonable.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter D, Chapter 711, Health and Safety
- 16 Code, is amended by adding Section 711.0515 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 711.0515. INJUNCTIVE RELIEF. In addition to bringing
- 18 an action under Section 711.051, the attorney general at the
- 19 request of the Texas Funeral Service Commission may bring an action
- 20 for injunctive relief to enforce this chapter or a rule or order
- 21 adopted by the commission under this chapter.
- SECTION 4. Subchapter D, Chapter 711, Health and Safety
- 23 Code, is amended by adding Section 711.0521 to read as follows:
- Sec. 711.0521. CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR INTERFERING WITH A
- 25 PERSON'S RIGHT TO REASONABLE INGRESS AND EGRESS. (a) A person
- 26 commits an offense if the person interferes with another person's
- 27 right to reasonable ingress and egress under Section 711.041.

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- 1 (b) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 2 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 3 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 4 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 5 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 6 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 7 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 8 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that
- 9 date.
- 10 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
