Section 55.007, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 22 Sec. 55.007. DUTIES OF COMMITTEE. The committee shall: 23 24 (1) prepare a port mission plan;

No. 3758 (2) review each project eligible to be funded under 1 this chapter and make recommendations for approval or disapproval 2 3 to the department; 4 (3) every two years [maintain trade data information 5 that will assist ports in this state and international trade; 6 [(4) annually] prepare a list of projects that have 7 been recommended by the committee, including: 8 (A) the recommended funding level for each project; and 9 if staged implementation of the project is 10 (B) appropriate, the funding requirements for each stage; and 11 (4) $\left[\frac{5}{5}\right]$ advise the commission and the department on 12 matters relating to port authorities. 13 SECTION 4.
