- 5 SECTION 1. Section 55.001(5), Transportation Code,
- amended to read as follows: 6
- 7 (5) "Port security, transportation, or facility
- project" means a project that is necessary or convenient for the 8
- proper operation of a public maritime port and that will improve the
- security, movement, and intermodal transportation of cargo or 10
- passengers in commerce and trade. 11
- SECTION 2. Section 55.006(a), Transportation Code, 12 is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 (a) The committee consists of seven members appointed by the
- commission. The members shall be appointed as follows: 15
- 16 (1)one member from the Port of Houston Authority;
- 17 (2) three members who represent <u>maritime</u> ports on the
- upper Texas coast; and 18
- (3) three members who represent maritime ports on the 19
- 20 lower Texas coast.
- 21 SECTION 3. Section 55.007, Transportation Code, is amended
- to read as follows: 22
- Sec. 55.007. DUTIES OF COMMITTEE. The committee shall: 23
- 24 (1) prepare a port mission plan;

- 1 (2) review each project eligible to be funded under
- 2 this chapter and make recommendations for approval or disapproval
- 3 to the department;
- 4 (3) [maintain trade data information that will assist
- 5 ports in this state and international trade;
- 6 $\left[\frac{(4)}{(4)}\right]$ annually prepare a list of projects that have

- 10 (B) if staged implementation of the project is
