Section 1701.253, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Subsection (k) to read as follows: 6 (k) As part of the minimum curriculum requirements, the 7 commission shall establish a statewide comprehensive education and 8 9 training program for officers licensed under this chapter that covers the laws of this state and of the United States pertaining to 10 peace officers. 11 12 SECTION 2. Section 1701.351, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows: 13 14 (a-1) As part of the continuing education programs under Subsection (a), a peace officer must complete a training and 15 16 education program that covers recent changes to the laws of this state and of the United States pertaining to peace officers. 17 18 SECTION 3. Section 1701.352(b), Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows: 19 (b) The commission shall require a state, county, special 20 district, or municipal agency that appoints or employs peace 21 officers to provide each peace officer with a training program at 22 23 least once every 48 months that is approved by the commission and 24 consists of:

1 (1) topics selected by the agency; and 2 (2) for an officer holding only a basic proficiency certificate, not more than 20 hours of education and training that 3 contain curricula incorporating the learning objectives developed 4 5 by the commission regarding: 6 (A) civil rights, racial sensitivity, and cultural diversity; and 7 unless determined by the agency head to be 8 (B) 9 inconsistent with the officer's assigned duties: (i) the recognition and documentation of 10 cases that involve child abuse or neglect, family violence, and 11 12 sexual assault; and (ii) 13 issues concerning sex offender 14 characteristics. 15 SECTION 4. Section 1701.402, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Subsections (h) and (i) to read as follows: 16 17 (h) As a requirement for an intermediate proficiency certificate, an officer must complete an education and training 18 program on investigative topics established by the commission under 19 Section 1701.253(b). 20 21 (i) As a requirement for an intermediate proficiency certificate, an officer must complete an education and training 22 program on civil rights, racial sensitivity, and cultural diversity 23 24 established by the commission under Section 1701.253(c). 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
