## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 12.101, Education Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
7	follows:
8	(b) The State Board of Education may grant a charter for an
9	open-enrollment charter school only to an applicant that meets any
10	financial, governing, and operational standards adopted by the
11	commissioner under this subchapter. [The State Board of Education
12	may not grant a total of more than 215 charters for an open
13	enrollment charter school.
14	(b-1) A charter holder may establish one or more new
15	open-enrollment charter school campuses under a charter without
16	applying for authorization from the State Board of Education if:
17	(1) the open-enrollment charter school district is
18	rated as academically acceptable or higher under Subchapter D,
19	Chapter 39; and
20	(2) no campus operating under the charter has been
21	rated as academically unacceptable for any two of the three
22	preceding school years or such a campus has been closed; and
23	(3) the charter holder provides written notice, in the
24	time, manner, and form provided by commissioner rule, to the State

- 1 Board of Education and the commissioner of the establishment of any
- 2 <u>campus under this subsection.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This act applies beginning with the 2009-2010
- 4 school year.
- 5 SECTION 3. This act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 act takes effect September 1, 2009.
