1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the designation of a portion of U.S. Highway 59 as the  
1-10 Trooper Scott Burns Memorial Highway.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
1-13 is amended by adding Section 225.081 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 225.081. TROOPER SCOTT BURNS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)  
1-15 U.S. Highway 59 between the northern corporate limits of the City of  
1-16 Jefferson and the southern corporate limits of the City of Linden is  
1-17 designated as the Trooper Scott Burns Memorial Highway.

1-18 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-19 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
1-20 highway number, the designation as the Trooper Scott Burns Memorial  
1-21 Highway, and any other appropriate information; and

1-22 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
1-23 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
