AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain disputes involving residential construction
 3 projects employing undocumented workers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 426.001, Property Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 7 follows:

- 8 (b-1) Chapters 426 through 429 do not apply to a dispute if:
- 9 (1) the builder or any subcontractor of the builder
- 10 employs an undocumented worker for the construction project that is
- 11 the subject of the dispute; and
- 12 (2) the builder has registered 100 homes or more with
- 13 the commission during the commission's preceding fiscal year.
- 14 (c) For the purposes of this section:
- 15 (1) "Damage[, "damage] to goods" does not include
- 16 damage to a home.
- 17 (2) "Undocumented worker" means a person who is not
- 18 lawfully entitled to be present and employed in the United States.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
