(a) The commission by rule shall implement 9 reasonably streamlined processes for issuing permits required to 10 construct a rock crusher that meets the requirements provided by 11 this section. 12 (b) The processes adopted under this section must provide 13 for the commission to take final action on an application for a 14 permit not later than the 60th day after the date the commission 15 16 receives an administratively complete application if: (1) the commission determines that the applicant's 17 compliance history is in the highest classification under Sections 18 5.753 and 5.754, Water Code, and rules adopted and procedures 19 developed under those sections; 20 21 (2) the applicant agrees to create a buffer zone around the rock crusher and the quarry associated with the rock 22 23 crusher in accordance with commission rules; 24 (3) the applicant agrees to operate the rock crusher

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1	and the quarry associated with the rock crusher in accordance with
2	best practices as determined by commission rule; and
3	(4) following the closure of the quarry associated
4	with the rock crusher, the applicant agrees to reclaim the quarry in
5	accordance with commission rules.
6	(c) When acting under a rule adopted under this section, the
7	commission shall use public meetings, informal conferences, or
8	advisory committees to gather the opinions and advice of interested
9	persons.
10	(d) The permit processes authorized by this section are not
11	subject to the requirements relating to a contested case hearing
12	under this chapter, Chapter 5, Water Code, or Subchapters C-G,
13	Chapter 2001, Government Code.
14	SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2010, the Texas
15	Commission on Environmental Quality shall adopt rules under Section
16	382.067, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
