- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. The Texas Racing Act (Article 179e, Vernon's
- 5 Texas Civil Statutes), is amended by adding Article 9A to read as
- 6 follows:

7 ARTICLE 9A. TEXAS DERBY

- 8 Sec. 9A.001. TEXAS DERBY. (a) The commission shall
- 9 establish the Texas Derby as an annual grade 1 stakes race of
- 10 Texas-bred thoroughbred and quarter horses in this state.
- 11 (b) The commission shall set the date of and the location
- 12 for the Texas Derby. The Texas Derby must be held annually at one of
- 13 the class 1 racetracks in this state on a rotating basis as
- 14 determined by the commission.
- 15 (c) Not later than January 1, 2010, the commission shall
- 16 establish the annual rotation for the location of the Texas Derby by
- 17 conducting a blind drawing of the names of each class 1 racetrack in
- 18 this state. This subsection expires January 1, 2011.
- 19 Sec. 9A.002. QUALIFYING RACES. (a) The commission shall
- 20 <u>establish two annual races of Texas-bred thoroughbred and quarter</u>
- 21 horses to qualify horses for entry into the Texas Derby.
- 22 (b) The commission shall establish for each qualifying
- 23 race:
- 24 (1) the date on which each race will be conducted,

- 1 provided the date is not the same for each race; and
- 2 (2) the class 1 racetrack where each qualifying race
- 3 will be conducted, provided that each race is conducted at a
- 4 different racetrack in a county with a population of at least two
- 5 million or adjacent to a county with a population of at least two
- 6 million.
- 7 (c) A horse is not eligible to run in a qualifying race or
- 8 the Texas Derby unless the horse:
- 9 <u>(1) is a Texas-bred thoroughbred or quarter horse; and</u>
- 10 (2) is not more than three years of age.
- 11 (d) A horse that finishes first, second, or third in a race
- 12 under this section qualifies to run in the Texas Derby race
- 13 established under Section 9A.001 of this Act.
- 14 Sec. 9A.003. INSPECTION AND EXAMINATION OF HORSE. (a) For
- 15 each qualifying race conducted under Section 9A.002 of this Act and
- 16 for the Texas Derby, the commission shall appoint a veterinarian to
- 17 supervise the inspection and examination of each horse entered in
- 18 the race to determine whether the horse is qualified to participate
- 19 in the race.
- 20 (b) The commission, in consultation with veterinarians,
- 21 shall by rule establish a list of documentation that must be
- 22 presented to the veterinarian appointed under Subsection (a) of
- 23 this section for each race to demonstrate that the horse is
- 24 qualified to run in the race.
- Sec. 9A.004. TEXAS DERBY PURSE FUND. (a) The commission
- 26 shall establish a Texas Derby purse fund.
- 27 (b) The commission shall annually contribute \$3 million to

- 1 the Texas Derby purse fund from money allocated and available to the
- 2 commission for any purpose, including money specifically dedicated
- 3 to purse funds.
- 4 (c) A horse racing association conducting a qualifying race
- 5 under Section 9A.002 of this Act or the Texas Derby shall:
- 6 (1) collect an entry fee from each owner of a horse
- 7 entered in the race; and
- 8 (2) remit to the commission a portion of the fees in
- 9 the amount determined by the commission to ensure that the purse for
- 10 the Texas Derby is at least \$5 million, including the amount
- 11 contributed by the commission.
- 12 (d) The commission shall adopt rules for accounting, audit,
- 13 and distribution of money from the Texas Derby purse fund to winners
- 14 of the race.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
