H.B. No. 3841

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to requiring joint elections for trustees of common school  
3 districts.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 11, Education Code, is  
6 amended by adding Section 11.305 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 11.305. JOINT ELECTIONS REQUIRED: COMMON SCHOOL  
8 DISTRICT. (a) Notwithstanding former Section 22.02, as it existed  
9 on May 1, 1995, an election for trustees of a common school district  
10 shall be held on the same date as:

11 (1) the election for the members of the governing body  
12 of a municipality located in the school district; or

13 (2) the general election for state and county  
14 officers.

15 (b) Elections held on the same date as provided by  
16 Subsection (a) shall be held as a joint election under Chapter 271,  
17 Election Code.

18 (c) The voters of a joint election under this section shall  
19 be served by common polling places consistent with Section  
20 271.003(b), Election Code.

21 (d) The board of trustees of a common school district  
22 changing an election date to comply with this section shall adjust  
23 the terms of office of its members to conform to the new election  
24 date.

1           SECTION 2. Not later than December 31, 2009, the board of  
2 trustees of a common school district must:

3                   (1) change the date on which the school district holds  
4 its general election for trustees to allow the district to hold its  
5 election on the same date as the election for members of the  
6 governing body of a municipality located in the school district or  
7 on the same date as the general election for state and county  
8 officers, as required by Section 11.305, Education Code, as added  
9 by this Act; and

10                   (2) adjust the terms of office of school district  
11 trustees as necessary to conform to the change of the election date  
12 made under Subdivision (1) of this section.

13           SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
