5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 29.001, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	Sec. 29.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "off-highway
9	vehicle" means:
10	(1) an all-terrain vehicle, as defined by Section
11	663.001, Transportation Code;
12	(2) an off-highway motorcycle; [and]
13	(3) <u>a recreational vehicle that:</u>
14	(A) is equipped with a non-straddle seat for the
15	use of:

- 16 <u>(i)</u> the rider; and
- 17 <u>(ii) a passenger, if the vehicle is</u>
- 18 <u>designed to transport a passenger;</u>
- 19 (B) is designed to propel itself with four or
- 20 more tires in contact with the ground;
- 21 (C) is designed by the manufacturer to be
- 22 operated for off-highway use only; and
- 23 (D) is not designed by the manufacturer primarily
- 24 for farming or lawn care; and

- 1 (4) any other motorized vehicle used for off-highway
- 2 recreation on:
- 3 (A) public land over which the department has
- 4 authority or on land purchased or leased by the department; or
- 5 (B) land acquired or developed under a grant made

- 11 SECTION 3. Section 29.011, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 12 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 (a) A person may not operate, ride, or be carried on an
- 15 off-highway vehicle on public property unless the person wears:
- 16 (1) a safety helmet that complies with United States
- 17 Department of Transportation standards; [and]
- 18 (2) eye protection; and
- 19 (3) seat belts, if the vehicle is equipped with seat
- 20 belts.
- 21 (c) This section does not apply to a motor vehicle that:
- (1) has at least four wheels and is registered by the
- 23 Texas Department of Transportation for use on a public highway,
- 24 unless the vehicle is an all-terrain vehicle as defined by Section

- 26 (2) has four wheels and is equipped with bench or

- 1 construction to reduce the risk of injury to an occupant of the
- 2 vehicle in case of the vehicle's rollover; or
- 3 (3) is in the process of being loaded into or unloaded
- 4 from a trailer or another vehicle used to transport the motor
- 5 vehicle.
- 6 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 7 29.011, Parks and Wildlife Code, applies to an offense committed on
- 8 or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed
- 9 before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in
- 10 effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is
- 11 continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section,
- 12 an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if
- 13 any element of the offense was committed before that date.
- 14 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
