4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Title 12, Insurance Code, is amended by adding
6	Chapter 3504 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 3504. INFORMATION CONCERNING PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY
8	INSURANCE
9	Sec. 3504.001. DEFINITIONS. (a) In this chapter
10	"Professional Liability Insurance" means a type of liability
11	<pre>insurance that covers:</pre>
12	(1) legal liability for damages due to injuries to
13	other persons, damage to their property, or other damage or loss to
14	such other persons (including the expenses of litigation and
15	settlement) resulting from or arising out of any tortuous act,
16	error, or omission of the covered individual in common law,
17	statutory, or constitutional causes of action while in performance
18	of such individual's official duties.
19	(2) the cost of legal representation for the covered
20	individual in connection with any administrative or judicial
21	proceeding (including any investigation or disciplinary
22	proceeding) relating to any act, error, or omission of the covered
23	individual while in performance of such individual's official
24	duties.

- 1 (b) "Issuer" means an insurance company, reciprocal or
- 2 interinsurance exchange, mutual insurance company, capital stock
- 3 company, county mutual insurance company, Lloyd's plan, or other
- 4 legal entity authorized to write professional liability insurance
- 5 policies in this state.
- 6 (c) "Rate" means the cost of insurance per exposure unit,
- 7 whether expressed as a single number or as a prospective loss cost,
- 8 with an adjustment to account for the treatment of expenses,
- 9 profit, and individual insurer variation in loss experience, and
- 10 before any application of individual risk variations based on loss
- 11 or expense considerations.
- 12 Sec. 3504.002. REPORT. (a) Each Professional Liability
- 13 issuer authorized to issue professional liability insurance
- 14 polices in this state shall submit a report to the department
- 15 containing rates, profit margins, the total number of claims paid,
- 16 the number of claims filed, exclusions in coverage, and the types of
- 17 coverage being offered.
- 18 (b) If the department determines that the information filed
- 19 by an insurer under this chapter is incomplete or otherwise
- 20 deficient, the department may request additional information from
- 21 <u>the insurer.</u>
- 22 <u>(c) The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to</u>
- 23 implement this section, including rules concerning any applicable
- 24 reporting period and the form of the report required in subsection
- 25 (a)<u>.</u>
- Sec. 3504.003. INTERNET POSTING; CONSUMER HOTLINE. (a)
- 27 The department shall post on the department's Internet website:

- 1 (1) the information contained in the reports received
- 2 under Section 3504.002; and
- 3 (2) The department shall operate a toll-free telephone
- 4 hotline to respond to consumer inquiries concerning professional
- 5 <u>liability insurance.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. The commissioner of insurance shall adopt rules
- 7 under Section 3504.002(c), Insurance Code, as added by this Act,
- 8 not later than January 1, 2010. The rules must require Professional
- 9 Liability issuers to submit the first report under Section
- 10 3504.002, Insurance Code, as added by this Act, not later than April
- 11 1, 2010.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
