A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the establishment of a program at the University of North Texas to provide financial incentives to certain students who 3 agree to teach bilingual education, English as a second language, 4 5 or Spanish in certain public schools. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 105, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 105.205 to read as follows: 8 9 Sec. 105.205. FINANCIAL INCENTIVE PROGRAM TO PREPARE TEACHERS IN BILINGUAL EDUCATION, ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE, AND 10 SPANISH. The University of North Texas shall establish and 11 administer a program to provide financial incentives such as 12 tuition assistance or student loan repayment to students at 13 14 institutions of higher education in the Dallas-Fort Worth area who: 15 (1) agree to: 16 (A) enroll in educator preparation programs at the University of North Texas; and 17 18 (B) obtain, within the period prescribed by the university, certification to teach bilingual education, English as 19 a second language, or Spanish; 20 21 (2) accept, during the first school year that begins 22 after the date the student becomes certified, an offer of full-time 23 employment to teach bilingual education, English as a second language, or Spanish in a public elementary or secondary school in 24

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1 the Dallas-Fort Worth area; and

2 (3) teach bilingual education, English as a second
3 language, or Spanish at that school for at least two school years.
4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
