- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 51.3062, Education Code, is amended by
- 8 adding Subsections (o-1) and (o-2) to read as follows:
- 9 (o-1) As a result of its evaluation under Subsection (o),
- 10 the board shall establish pilot programs, using funds appropriated
- 11 to the board, at institutions of higher education to develop
- 12 innovative strategies for addressing a student's deficiencies in
- 13 the student's readiness to perform freshman-level academic
- 14 coursework.
- 15 (o-2) In connection with its evaluation under Subsection
- 16 (o), the board shall perform an analysis of the effectiveness of the
- 17 requirements of this section in efficiently meeting the needs of
- 18 students in becoming ready to perform freshman-level academic
- 19 coursework. The analysis must examine the effects of the
- 20 requirements of this section on the progress and success of
- 21 students who enroll in an institution of higher education. Based on
- 22 the analysis, the board shall make recommendations for improving
- 23 <u>developmental</u> coursework and assessments, including
- 24 recommendations for legislation, and shall report its findings and

- 1 recommendations to each institution of higher education and the
- 2 legislature not later than November 1, 2010. This subsection
- 3 <u>expires January 1, 2011.</u>
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
