6 (3) preventing, <u>disrupting</u>, or attempting to prevent 7 <u>or disrupt</u> by force or violence or the threat of force or violence a 8 lawful assembly authorized by the school administration so that a 9 person attempting to participate in the assembly is unable to 10 participate due to the use of force or violence or due to a 11 reasonable fear that force or violence is likely to occur; or

12 (4) [disrupting by force or violence or the threat of 13 force or violence a lawful assembly in progress; or

[(5)] obstructing or restraining the passage of a person at an exit or entrance to the campus or property or preventing or attempting to prevent by force or violence or by threats of force or violence the ingress or egress of a person to or from the property or campus without the authorization of the administration of the school.

20 (b-1) In this section, "obstruct" has the meaning assigned
 21 by Section 42.03, Penal Code.

22 SECTION 4. Section 37.124, Education Code, is amended by 23 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

SECTION 7. Section 37.123(d), Education Code, is repealed. 3 4 SECTION 8. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An 5 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed 6 by the law in effect at the time the offense was committed, and the 7 8 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For the purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 9 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 10 before that date. 11

SECTION 9. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
