## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to testing liquefied petroleum gas systems in certain
- 3 school facilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 113.352, Natural Resources Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 113.352. DUTY TO TEST FOR LEAKAGE. (a) Each school
- 8 district shall perform <a href="leakage">leakage</a> [pressure] tests for leakage on the
- 9 LP-gas piping system in each school district facility at least
- 10 biennially. The tests must be performed before the beginning of the
- 11 school year.
- 12 (b) The school district may perform the <a href="leakage">leakage</a> [pressure]
- 13 tests on a two-year cycle under which the tests are performed for
- 14 the LP-gas piping systems of approximately one-half of the
- 15 facilities each year.
- 16 (c) If a school district operates one or more school
- 17 district facilities on a year-round calendar, the leakage
- 18 [pressure] test in each of those facilities must be conducted and
- 19 reported not later than July 1 of the year in which the test is
- 20 performed.
- 21 SECTION 2. Sections 113.353(a) and (b), Natural Resources
- 22 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 23 (a) The school district shall perform the leakage
- 24 [pressure] test to determine whether the LP-gas piping system holds

- 1 at least the amount of pressure specified by the <a href="commission">commission</a>
- 2 [National Fire Protection Association 54, National Fuel Gas Code].
- 3 (b) The leakage [pressure] test must be conducted in
- 4 accordance with commission rules [National Fire Protection
- 5 Association 54].
- 6 SECTION 3. Sections 113.354(a) and (c), Natural Resources
- 7 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) A school district shall retain documentation [provide
- 9 written notice to the commission] specifying the date and the
- 10 result of each <u>leakage</u> [pressure] test or other inspection of <u>each</u>
- 11 [the] LP-gas piping system until at least the fifth anniversary of
- 12 the date the test or other inspection was performed.
- 13 (c) The commission <u>may review a school district's</u>
- 14 documentation of each leakage test or other inspection conducted by
- 15 the school district [shall maintain a copy of the notice provided
- 16 under Subsection (a) until at least the first anniversary of the
- 17 date the commission received the notice].
- 18 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 19 beginning with the 2009-2010 school year.
- 20 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
