11	(1) "Academic year" includes the summer session that
12	follows the spring semester of an academic year.
13	(2) "General academic teaching institution" has the
14	meaning assigned by Section 61.003.

16	(A) tuition for which the rates are prescribed by

- 10 Act, applies beginning with tuition charged by public institutions
- 11 of higher education for the 2010-2011 academic year. Tuition
- 12 charged by an institution of higher education in an academic year
- 13 before that academic year is covered by the law in effect before the
- 14 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
- 15 effect for that purpose.
- 16 SECTION 3. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
- 17 shall adopt the rules required by Section 54.017, Education Code,
- 18 as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after the effective
- 19 date of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
