BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 551, Government Code, is
amended by adding Section 551.0415 to read as follows:

9 Sec. 551.0415. GOVERNING BODY OF MUNICIPALITY: REPORTS ABOUT ITEMS OF COMMUNITY INTEREST REGARDING WHICH NO ACTION WILL BE 10 11 TAKEN. (a) Notwithstanding Sections 551.041 and 551.042, a quorum of the governing body of a municipality may receive from municipal 12 staff and a member of the governing body may make a report about 13 14 items of community interest during a meeting of the governing body without having given notice of the subject of the report as required 15 16 by this subchapter if no action is taken and, except as provided by Section 551.042, possible action is not discussed regarding the 17 information provided in the report. 18

19 (b) For purposes of Subsection (a), "items of community 20 interest" includes:
