- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 51.9112 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.9112. VETERAN'S TEMPORARY HOUSING IN INSTITUTION
- 8 HOUSING FACILITY. (a) In this section, "institution of higher
- 9 education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- 10 (b) A veteran receiving health care services from a
- 11 hospital, health clinic, or other facility operated by the Veterans
- 12 <u>Health Administration of the United States Department of Veterans</u>
- 13 Affairs may stay, free of charge, in a vacant room of a housing
- 14 facility located at and operated by an institution of higher
- 15 education while the veteran is receiving the health care services
- 16 if:
- 17 (1) the institution is able to accommodate and
- 18 approves the veteran's request for temporary housing and the
- 19 institution is located a reasonable distance from the hospital,
- 20 health clinic, or other facility providing health care services to
- 21 the veteran; and
- 22 (2) the veteran resides more than 100 miles from the
- 23 hospital, health clinic, or other facility providing health care
- 24 services to the veteran.

- (c) The primary or other necessary caregiver to a veteran described by Subsection (b) may stay, free of charge, in a vacant room of a housing facility located at and operated by an institution of higher education while the veteran is receiving health care services from a facility operated by the Veterans Health Administration of the United States Department of Veterans Affairs if:
- 8 (1) the institution is able to accommodate and
 9 approves the caregiver's request for temporary housing and the
 10 institution is located a reasonable distance from the facility
 11 providing health care services;
- 12 <u>(2)</u> Subsection (b)(2) applies; and
- 13 (3) the veteran is staying either at an institution
 14 housing facility as provided by Subsection (b) or at the facility
 15 providing health care services.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
