16	(2) in assisting military veterans and eligible family
17	members in understanding and obtaining the benefits available under

19	(b) A person described by Subsection (a) must be available
20	to assist persons as described by Subsection (a)(2) during regular

1 attributable to the requirements of this section and may 2 appropriate money for that purpose.

3 SECTION 2. A public institution of higher education shall 4 comply with Section 56.006, Education Code, as added by this Act, 5 concerning employment of a person to provide student financial 6 assistance for military veterans and their families not later than 7 January 1, 2010.

8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
