A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 56, Education Code, is

- 8 Sec. 56.006. EMPLOYEE TRAINED IN STUDENT FINANCIAL
- 9 ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS FOR VETERANS AND FAMILIES. (a) Each

- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
