23	(b) A Type A corporation may contract with a nonprofit

to assist the corporation with the administration of the project. 1 2 The authorizing municipality may designate for the purposes of this section not more than one-eighth of the tax revenue that the 3 4 municipality is entitled to receive from any sales and use tax 5 adopted under this chapter. 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2009. 10
