(a) Notwithstanding 8 Section 531.0055, Government Code, or any other law, the department 9 shall perform all administrative personnel, human resources, and 10 payroll functions for state schools and employees of state schools. 11 12 (b) The department shall ensure that each state school has at least one on-site employee dedicated to the performance of 13 14 administrative personnel, human resources, and payroll functions for the state school. 15 16 (c) The department may not contract for the performance of administrative personnel, human resources, or payroll functions or 17 otherwise outsource those functions to a private person. 18 SECTION 2. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective 19 date of this Act, the Department of Aging and Disability Services 20 21 and the Health and Human Services Commission shall coordinate the 22 transfer of all administrative personnel, human resources, and

23 payroll functions relating to state schools in accordance with 24 Section 161.0521, Human Resources Code, as added by this Act.
