- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 521, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 521.006 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 521.006. NOTICE TO ACCOMPANY RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY
- 8 INSURANCE RENEWAL POLICY. (a) Each renewal of a residential
- 9 property insurance policy must contain on the first page:
- 10 (1) a table that clearly lists the premium charged
- 11 under the policy before renewal, the new premium charged under the
- 12 renewal policy, and the percent change, if any, between these
- 13 <u>amounts</u>, and

- 14 (2) an explanation, in plain language, of any changes
- 15 in the coverage of the policy.
- 16 (b) If there is any increase in the premium or change in the
- 17 coverage of the renewal policy, the first page of the renewal policy
- 18 must contain a statement advising the consumer of the Department's
- 19 website www.helpinsure.com for comparing premiums and coverages of
- 20 different insurers' policies.
- 21 (c) The commissioner shall adopt appropriate wording for
- 22 the notices.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an insurance policy
- 24 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1,

- 1 2010. A policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before
- 2 January 1, 2010, is governed by the law as it existed immediately
- $3\,$ before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in
- 4 effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
