A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the election of certain members of the board of trustees
- 3 of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 821.001(5), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (5) "Board of trustees" means the board appointed or
- 8 <u>elected</u> under this subtitle to administer the retirement system.
- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 825, Government Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Section 825.0021 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 825.0021. ELECTED TRUSTEES. (a) The retirement
- 12 system shall provide for the direct election of two persons to serve
- 13 on the board of trustees who are former members of the retirement
- 14 system who have retired and are receiving benefits from the
- 15 retirement system, and who shall be elected by former members of the
- 16 retirement system who have retired and are receiving benefits from
- 17 the retirement system.
- 18 (b) The two persons elected under Subsection (a) hold office
- 19 <u>for staggered terms.</u>
- 20 <u>(c) The board of trustees by rule shall adopt procedures to</u>
- $\underline{\text{implement this section.}}$ The procedures must include a method for
- 22 filling a vacancy in an elected position.
- SECTION 3. Sections 825.0032(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 24 are amended to read as follows:

- 1 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a person is not
- 2 eligible for appointment or election to the board if the person or
- 3 the person's spouse:
- 4 (1) is employed by or participates in the management
- 5 of a business entity or other organization receiving funds from the
- 6 retirement system;
- 7 (2) owns or controls, directly or indirectly, more
- 8 than a 10 percent interest in a business entity or other
- 9 organization receiving funds from the retirement system; or
- 10 (3) uses or receives a substantial amount of tangible
- 11 goods, services, or funds from the retirement system, other than
- 12 compensation or reimbursement authorized by law for board
- 13 membership, attendance, or expenses.
- (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to employment by,
- 15 participation in the management of, or ownership or control of an
- 16 interest in a business entity or other organization on behalf of the
- 17 retirement system. Subsection (a)(3) does not apply to a person who
- 18 is nominated for appointment under Section 825.002(c), (d), or (e)
- 19 or elected under Section 825.0021.
- SECTION 4. Sections 825.0041(a) and (c), Government Code,
- 21 are amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a) A person who is appointed <u>or elected</u> to and qualifies
- 23 for office as a member of the board of trustees may not vote,
- 24 deliberate, or be counted as a member in attendance at a meeting of
- 25 the board until the person completes a training program that
- 26 complies with this section.
- 27 (c) A person appointed or elected to the board of trustees

- 1 is entitled to reimbursement under Section 825.007 for the travel
- 2 expenses incurred in attending the training program regardless of
- 3 whether the attendance at the program occurs before or after
- 4 the person qualifies for office.
- 5 SECTION 5. Section 825.009(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A trustee appointed from a slate of members nominated by
- 8 members of the retirement system under Section 825.002 or elected
- 9 by members of the retirement system under Section 825.0021 is
- 10 entitled to leave with pay from the trustee's public school
- 11 employer to attend to the official business of the retirement
- 12 system.
- SECTION 6. Sections 825.010(a) and (c), Government Code,
- 14 are amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) It is a ground for removal from the board that a trustee:
- 16 (1) does not have at the time of taking office the
- 17 qualifications required for the trustee's position;
- 18 (2) does not maintain during service on the board the
- 19 qualifications required for the trustee's position;
- 20 (3) violates a prohibition established by Section
- 21 825.002(b) or 825.0032;
- 22 (4) cannot because of illness or disability discharge
- 23 the trustee's duties for a substantial part of the term for which
- 24 the trustee is appointed or elected; or
- 25 (5) is absent from more than half of the regularly
- 26 scheduled board meetings that the person is eligible to attend
- 27 during a calendar year without an excuse approved by a majority vote

- 1 of the board.
- 2 (c) If the executive director has knowledge that a potential
- 3 ground for removal exists, the executive director shall notify the
- 4 presiding officer of the board of the ground. The presiding officer
- 5 shall then notify the appropriate appointing officer, if any, and
- 6 the attorney general that a potential ground for removal exists. If
- 7 the potential ground for removal involves the presiding officer,
- 8 the executive director shall notify the next highest officer of the
- 9 board, who shall notify the appropriate appointing officer, if any,
- 10 and the attorney general that a potential ground for removal
- 11 exists.
- 12 SECTION 7. Section 825.003, Government Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 8. (a) In this section, "board" means the board of
- 14 trustees of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas.
- 15 (b) The board shall adopt procedures to implement Section
- 16 825.0021(a), Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 17 December 31, 2009.
- 18 (c) The procedures adopted by the board shall facilitate the
- 19 elections required under Section 825.0021(a), Government Code, as
- 20 added by this Act, so that the first elections are conducted not
- 21 later than May 1, 2010.
- 22 (d) A person elected at the first election under Section
- 23 825.0021(a), Government Code, as added by this Act, shall serve a
- 24 term beginning as soon as practicable after the date of the election
- 25 and taking the oath of office. One person elected under Section
- 26 825.0021(a) shall serve a term that expires August 31, 2013, and the
- 27 other person elected under Section 825.0021(a) shall serve a term

- 1 that expires August 31, 2015, as determined according to the
- 2 board's procedures adopted under Section 825.0021(c), Government
- 3 Code, as added by this Act.
- 4 (e) Not later than the 10th day after the date of the first
- 5 election held under Section 825.0021, Government Code, as added by
- 6 this Act, the board shall post the election results on the Teacher
- 7 Retirement System of Texas publicly accessible Internet website.
- 8 SECTION 9. The term of a person serving on the board of
- 9 trustees of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas on December 1,
- 10 2009, and who was appointed to that position under Section 825.003,
- 11 Government Code, before the repeal of that section by this Act
- 12 expires on the date on which a person elected to serve on the board
- 13 at the first election held under Section 825.0021, Government Code,
- 14 as added by this Act, takes the oath of office.
- 15 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
