## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to an analysis of available federal funding, state-federal
- 3 matching expenditures, and related legislation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 403, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 403.0303 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 403.0303. ANALYSIS OF AVAILABLE FEDERAL MONEY. (a)
- 8 For each state fiscal biennium, the comptroller shall prepare a
- 9 report regarding federal money available to this state for
- 10 state-federal matching expenditures and for other purposes.
- 11 (b) The report must identify:

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- 12 (1) the amounts of state money expended each state
- 13 fiscal year of the then current state fiscal biennium on each
- 14 program or project that attracts federal matching money and the
- 15 amount of federal matching money for each program;
- 16 (2) for each of those programs identified under
- 17 Subdivision (1), the maximum amount of federal matching money this
- 18 state could qualify for during the succeeding state fiscal biennium
- 19 and the amount of expenditures of state money necessary for this
- 20 state to qualify for that maximum amount;
- 21 (3) additional programs or projects for which this
- 22 state could qualify for federal matching money during the
- 23 <u>succeeding state fiscal biennium and the amount of expenditures of</u>
- 24 state money necessary for this state to qualify for the maximum

- 1 amount available for those programs or projects; and
- 2 (4) the amount of money this state received in the then
- 3 current state fiscal biennium from federal sources and a comparison
- 4 of that amount to amounts received during that period by other
- 5 states.
- 6 (c) The report must include:
- 7 (1) an analysis of legislation enacted by the
- 8 legislature in the preceding two years that affects this state's
- 9 ability to attract or qualify for money from federal sources; and
- 10 (2) the comptroller's recommendations for changes in
- 11 legislation or in this state's budget for the purpose of maximizing
- 12 this state's receipt of money from federal sources.
- 13 (d) On or before the first day the legislature convenes in a
- 14 regular session, the comptroller shall publish the report prepared
- 15 under this section on the comptroller's publicly available Internet
- 16 website and provide the report to the governor, the lieutenant
- 17 governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
