(a) [An election on the adoption of a proposed 8 home-rule school district charter has no effect unless at least 25 9 percent of the registered voters of the district vote in the 10 11 election in which the adoption of the charter is on the ballot. 12 [(b)] An election on the adoption of a proposed amendment to a home-rule school district charter has no effect unless at least 13 five [20] percent of the registered voters of the district vote in 14 the election in which the adoption of the amendment is on the 15 ballot. 16 (b) [(c)] If the required number of voters prescribed by 17 Subsection (a) [or (b)] do not vote in the election, the board of 18 trustees shall order an election on the issue to be held on the 19 first uniform election date: 20 21 (1) that occurs at least 45 days after the date the 22 election is ordered; and 23 (2) on which one or more elections are to be held, the 24 combination of which covers all of the territory of the school

2 (c) [(d)] If the required number of voters prescribed by
3 Subsection (a) [or (b)] do not vote at an election ordered as
4 required by Subsection (b) [(c)], the board of trustees may
5 continue to order elections on the issue in accordance with
6 Subsection (b) [(c)] until the required minimum voter turnout is
7 achieved.

8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
