## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 92, Property Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 92.021 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 92.021. LIABILITY INSURANCE. (a) A landlord who rents
8	a dwelling shall not require a tenant to obtain a liability
9	insurance policy as a condition of tenancy, or take any adverse
10	action against a tenant for failing to obtain an insurance policy.
11	(b) A landlord may notify a tenant of the availability of a
12	liability insurance policy that insures the contents of the
13	premises against damage or loss so long as the tenant is given a
14	separate disclosure in 14 point type three days prior to the
15	earliest of the execution of any agreement with the landlord, the
16	payment of any funds to the landlord, or moving into the premises
17	that:
18	(1) explains the specific type of insurance policy
19	required to be obtained by the tenant, and the result of the failure
20	of the tenant to retain insurance during the term of the lease;
21	(2) the cost of such a policy for the term of the lease
22	if provided by the landlord, and the cost of such a policy with at
23	least two other insurance carriers that provide a policy with
24	similar terms;

- 1 (3) the terms of the policy; and
- 2 (4) the contact information for the Texas Department
- 3 of Insurance.
- 4 (c) In order to demonstrate compliance with subsection (b),
- 5 <u>a landlord must have a copy of the notice delivered to the tenant</u>
- 6 with the tenant's signature acknowledging receipt of the notice and
- 7 the date of receipt.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a lease that is first
- 9 entered into on or after the effective date of this Act. A lease
- 10 entered into or renewed before the effective date of this Act is
- 11 governed by the law that applied to the lease immediately before the
- 12 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 13 that purpose.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
