- 2 relating to notifications to certain purchasers of real property

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 13.257(c), Water Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:

- 8 (c) This section does not apply to:
- 9 (1) a transfer of title under any type of lien
- 10 foreclosure;
- 11 (2) a transfer of title by deed in cancellation of
- 12 indebtedness secured by a lien on the property conveyed;
- 13 (3) a transfer of title by reason of a will or probate
- 14 proceeding;
- 15 (4) a transfer of title to or from a governmental
- 16 entity;
- 17 (5) a transfer of title to property located within the
- 18 corporate limits of a municipality that is served by a municipally
- 19 <u>owned utility</u>;
- 20 (6) a transfer of title to property that receives
- 21 water or sewer service from a utility service provider on the date
- 22 the property is transferred;
- 23 (7) a transfer of title by a trustee in bankruptcy;
- 24 (8) a transfer of title by a mortgagee or beneficiary

- 1 under a deed of trust who acquired the property:
- 2 (A) at a sale conducted under a power of sale
- 3 conferred by a deed of trust or other contract lien;
- 4 (B) at a sale under a court judgment foreclosing
- 5 a lien; or
- 6 (C) by a deed in lieu of foreclosure;
- 7 (9) a transfer of title from one co-owner to another
- 8 co-owner;
- 9 (10) a transfer of title between spouses or to a person
- 10 in the lineal line of consanguinity of the transferor; or
- 11 (11) a transfer of a mineral interest, leasehold
- 12 interest, or security interest.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to a proposal to sell or convey real property made on or after the
- 15 effective date of this Act. A proposal to sell or convey real
- 16 property made before the effective date of this Act is covered by
- 17 the law in effect when the proposal was made, and the former law is
- 18 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
