A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to an exemption from the curriculum requirements for
- 3 automatic admission to public institutions of higher education for
- 4 certain students affected by a natural disaster.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 51.803(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) An applicant who does not satisfy the curriculum
- 9 requirements prescribed by Subsection (a)(2)(A)(i) or (ii) is
- 10 considered to have satisfied those requirements if the student
- 11 completed the portion of the recommended or advanced curriculum or
- 12 of the curriculum equivalent in content and rigor, as applicable,
- 13 that was available to the student but was unable to complete the
- 14 remainder of the curriculum solely because courses necessary to
- 15 complete the remainder were unavailable to the student at the
- 16 appropriate times in the student's high school career as a result of
- 17 course scheduling, lack of enrollment capacity, a natural disaster,
- 18 or another cause not within the student's control.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
