## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the use of state institutions of higher education to
- 3 provide training to state agency employees.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 656.043, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 656.043. DEFINITIONS [DEFINITION]. In this
- 8 subchapter:
- 9 (1) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning
- 10 assigned by Section 61.003, Education Code.
- 11 (2) "State[, "state] agency" means a department,
- 12 agency, or institution of this state, including an institution of
- 13 higher education as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 656.049, Government Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- Sec. 656.049. AUTHORITY TO CONTRACT. (a) A state agency
- 17 may contract with another state, local, or federal department,
- 18 agency, or institution, including a state-supported college or
- 19 university, to train or educate its administrators and employees or
- 20 may join in presenting a training or educational program.
- 21 (b) A state agency may not contract with a private person to
- 22 <u>train or educate a state agency administrator or employee if the</u>
- 23 agency is required under Section 656.050 to use an institution of
- 24 higher education to provide the training or education.

- 1 SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 656, Government Code, is
- 2 amended by adding Section 656.050 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 656.050. TRAINING PROVIDED BY INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
- 4 EDUCATION. (a) A state agency shall use an institution of higher
- 5 education to provide training or education to its administrators
- 6 and employees if the institution can provide the training or
- 7 education:
- 8 <u>(1) at a comparable level of quality but at a lower</u>
- 9 cost to the agency;
- 10 (2) on the subject matter required by the state
- 11 agency;
- 12 (3) in the geographic area in which the state agency
- 13 <u>administrator or employee is located;</u>
- 14 (4) not later than the date the agency requires the
- 15 training or education to be completed; and
- 16 (5) according to a schedule acceptable to the agency.
- 17 (b) A state agency may use an institution of higher
- 18 education to supplement or enhance the training or education
- 19 provided by full-time state agency employees to the agency's other
- 20 employees.
- 21 SECTION 4. Section 656.049, Government Code, as amended by
- 22 this Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or after the
- 23 effective date of this Act. A contract entered into before the
- 24 effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the
- 25 contract was entered into, and the former law is continued in effect
- 26 for that purpose.
- 27 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
