A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the requirement that governmental public notices be 3 published in Spanish-language newspapers. PUBLICATION OF PUBLIC NOTICES IN SPANISH-LANGUAGE 7 8 NEWSPAPER 9 Sec. 561.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: (1) "Public notice" means any notice that must be 10 published in a newspaper under Chapter 4, Election Code, or other 11 12 law by: 13 (A) a state agency or a state officer or 14 employee; or 15 (B) a political subdivision of this state or an 16 officer or employee of a political subdivision. (2) "Spanish-language newspaper" means a newspaper 17 that is printed in Spanish. 18 Sec. 561.002. PUBLICATION IN SPANISH-LANGUAGE NEWSPAPER BY 19 STATE AGENCY OR OFFICER. A state agency or a state officer or 20 employee with responsibility for publishing a public notice shall 21 publish the notice in Spanish in a Spanish-language newspaper of 22 23 general circulation in each county in which: 24 (1) the agency, officer, or employee is required to

1 publish the public notice; 2 (2) more than 50 percent of the population is of 3 Hispanic origin; and 4 (3) there is a Spanish-language newspaper of general 5 circulation. 6 Sec. 561.003. PUBLICATION IN SPANISH-LANGUAGE NEWSPAPER BY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION. (a) This section applies only to: 7 (1) a political subdivision, other than a county, any 8 portion of which is located in a county in which more than 50 9 10 percent of the population is of Hispanic origin; or (2) a county in which more than 50 percent of the 11 12 population is of Hispanic origin. (b) A political subdivision or an officer or employee of a 13 14 political subdivision with responsibility for publishing a public 15 notice shall publish the notice in Spanish in a Spanish-language newspaper of general circulation in each county in which: 16 17 (1) the political subdivision is located; and (2) there is a Spanish-language newspaper of general 18 19 circulation. Sec. 561.004. NOTICE IN ADDITION TO NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER 20 21 OTHER LAW. Notice published under this chapter is in addition to notice required by other law. 22
