## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the appointment of the director of the governor's
- 3 office of homeland security.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 421, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 421.006 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 421.006. DIRECTOR OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HOMELAND
- 8 SECURITY. (a) The governor, with the advice and consent of the
- 9 senate, shall appoint a director of the governor's office of
- 10 <u>homeland security.</u>
- 11 (b) The director of the governor's office of homeland
- 12 security serves a two-year term expiring February 1 of each
- 13 odd-numbered year. The director may be reappointed by the governor
- 14 with the advice and consent of the senate.
- 15 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable on or after the effective
- 16 date of this Act, the governor shall appoint a director of the
- 17 governor's office of homeland security to a term expiring February
- 18 1, 2011.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
