1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to information and assistance provided by the chief
1-9 appraiser to emergency management authorities.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 6, Tax Code, is amended by
1-12 adding Section 6.053 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 6.053. ASSISTANCE TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
1-14 AUTHORITIES. The chief appraiser may, if requested by the
1-15 emergency management authorities of a federal, state, or local
1-16 government agency, provide information and assistance pertinent to
1-17 disaster mitigation or recovery, including assisting in the
1-18 estimation of damage from an actual or potential disaster event.

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if this Act
1-20 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
1-21 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
1-22 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
1-23 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
