1-9 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-10 AN ACT

1-11 relating to memorial monuments on the Capitol grounds, including
1-12 the Tejano monument.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Chapter 443, Government Code, is amended by
1-15 adding Section 443.01525 to read as follows:

1-16 Sec. 443.01525. TEJANO MEMORIAL MONUMENT. The State
1-17 Preservation Board shall establish a Tejano memorial monument on
1-18 the historic south grounds of the Capitol that pays tribute to the
1-19 contributions of Tejanos to the State of Texas.

1-20 SECTION 2. Section 443.0152, Government Code, is amended by
1-21 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

1-22 (a-1) Except as provided by Sections 443.01525 and 448.034,
1-23 after September 1, 2009, no additional monuments may be placed on
1-24 the historic grounds of the Capitol.

1-25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
