- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 403.302, Government 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) In conducting the study, the comptroller shall 9 determine the taxable value of property in each school district:
- 10 (1) using, if appropriate, samples selected through 11 generally accepted sampling techniques;
- 12 (2) according to generally accepted standard valuation, statistical compilation, and analysis techniques;
- 14 (3) ensuring that different levels of appraisal on
- 15 sold and unsold property do not adversely affect the accuracy of the
- 16 study; and

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- 17 (4) ensuring that different levels of appraisal
- 18 resulting from protests determined under Section 41.43, Tax Code,
- 19 are appropriately adjusted in the study:
- 20 (A) by excluding from the samples used in the
- 21 study such properties that are determined to significantly vary
- 22 such that they adversely affect the accuracy and validity of the
- 23 study; or
- 24 (B) by using initial value prior to determination

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- 1 by 41.43, Tax Code, for such properties, in the sample and in the
- 2 study.
- 3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to the annual study conducted by Section 403.302, Government Code,
- 5 to determine taxable value for a tax year that begins on or after
- 6 January 1, 2009. The annual study to determine taxable value for a
- 7 tax year that begins before that date is covered by the law in
- 8 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the
- 9 prior law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
