## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to an odor nuisance ordinance enacted by a municipality. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 382.113(b), Health and Safety Code, is 4 5 amended to read as follows: 6 (b) An ordinance enacted by a municipality: 7 (1) must be consistent with this chapter and the commission's rules and orders; 8 (2) [and] may not make unlawful a condition or act 9 approved or authorized under this chapter or the commission's rules 10 11 or orders; and (3) must establish objective, ascertainable, and 12 13 measurable standards for any nuisance odors. 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 17 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
