- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 61.0664 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 61.0664. STUDY OF ACHIEVABLE COST-SAVING MEASURES;
- 10 REPORT. (a) The board shall conduct a study to identify achievable
- 11 cost-saving measures in the management and operation of
- 12 <u>institutions of higher education.</u>
- 13 (b) Not later than January 31, 2011, the board shall report
- 14 the results of the study required by Subsection (a) to the governor,
- 15 <u>lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of representatives, and</u>
- 16 presiding officer for each legislative standing committee with
- 17 primary jurisdiction over higher education. The report must
- 18 <u>include:</u>
- 19 <u>(1) the board's recommendations concerning</u>
- 20 cost-saving measures that are achievable at institutions of higher
- 21 education; and
- 22 (2) an estimate of the amount of money that would be
- 23 saved during a five-year period through the implementation of each
- 24 recommendation.

- 1 (c) This section expires January 31, 2011.
- 2 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
- 3 amended by adding Section 61.0665 to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 61.0665. STUDY ON USE AND AVAILABILITY OF ELECTRONIC
- 5 TEXTBOOKS. (a) The board shall conduct a study and recommend
- 6 policies regarding the use and availability of electronic textbooks
- 7 in higher education in this state and in other states. The study
- 8 and policy recommendations must include a specific focus on the
- 9 results of the pilot program implemented by The University of Texas
- 10 at Austin with respect to the use of electronic textbooks and must
- 11 address methods for encouraging the use of electronic textbooks at
- 12 public or private institutions of higher education in this state.
- 13 (b) Each student regent serving under Section 51.355 or
- 14 51.356 shall assist the board in performing the board's duties
- 15 under Subsection (a). The board shall establish procedures to
- 16 assist a student regent in complying with this subsection.
- 17 (c) The board may solicit and accept gifts and grants from
- 18 any public or private source to conduct the study and develop policy
- 19 recommendations under this section.
- 20 (d) Not later than December 1, 2010, the board shall make an
- 21 <u>initial report and recommendations based on the study to the</u>
- 22 governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of
- 23 representatives, and presiding officer of each legislative
- 24 standing committee with primary jurisdiction over higher
- 25 education. This subsection expires January 31, 2011.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
