## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to certification of an educator in Texas who is certified
- 3 in another state or country.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.052, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (e), (f), and (g) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) The board <u>shall</u> [may] issue a certificate to an educator
- 9 who applies for a certificate and:
- 10 (1) holds:
- 11 (A) a degree issued by an institution accredited
- 12 by a regional accrediting agency or group that is recognized by a
- 13 nationally recognized accreditation board; or
- 14 (B) a degree issued by an institution located in
- 15 a foreign country, if the degree is equivalent to a degree described
- 16 by Paragraph (A);
- 17 (2) holds an appropriate certificate or other
- 18 credential issued by another state or country; [and]
- 19 (3) performs satisfactorily on:
- 20 (A) the examination prescribed under Section
- 21 21.048; or
- 22 (B) if the educator holds a certificate or other
- 23 credential issued by another state or country, an examination
- 24 similar to and at least as rigorous as that described by Paragraph

- 1 (A) administered to the educator under the authority of that state;
- 2 and
- 3 (4) holds a certificate or other credential issued by
- 4 another state or country to teach mathematics, science, special
- 5 education, or bilingual education, or another subject area that the
- 6 commissioner determines has a shortage of teachers.
- 7 <u>(e) An educator who receives a certificate as provided by</u>
- 8 Subsection (a) must perform satisfactorily on the examination
- 9 prescribed under Section 21.048 not later than the second
- 10 anniversary of the date the certificate under Subsection (a) was
- 11 issued.
- 12 (f) The board shall post on the board's Internet website the
- 13 procedures for obtaining a certificate under Subsection (a).
- 14 (g) The commissioner shall provide guidance to school
- 15 districts that employ an educator certified as provided by
- 16 Subsection (a) on procedures to classify the educator as a highly
- 17 qualified teacher in a manner consistent with the No Child Left
- 18 Behind Act of 2001 (20 U.S.C. Section 6301 et seq.).
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
