- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 82.003, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 7 Code, is amended by adding subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 8 (c) If after service through the Secretary of State in the
- 9 manner prescribed by Chapter 17, Subchapter C the manufacturer
- 10 fails to answer or otherwise make an appearance in the time required
- 11 by law, it is conclusively presumed for the purposes of subsection
- 12 (a)(7)(b) that the manufacturer is not subject to the jurisdiction
- 13 of the court unless the seller is able to secure personal
- 14 jurisdiction of the manufacturer in the case.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 16 cause of action that is currently pending as well as a cause of
- 17 action that accrues on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
