- 6 as required by Subsection (e), the center shall publish the report

- 8 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2010, the Texas
- 9 Fusion Center shall submit the first annual report regarding
- 10 criminal street gangs and gang-related crime as required by Section

- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
