A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to child protective services. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 261.103, Family Code, is amended by 4 5 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows: 6 (d) The department or other entity receiving a report of abuse or neglect shall maintain an audio recording of each report 7 8 made over the telephone. The Department of Family and Protective 9 SECTION 2. (a) Services shall, in consultation with the Department of Public 10 11 Safety of the State of Texas, the office of the attorney general, 12 the Health and Human Services Commission, and the office of the governor, study the department's policies and procedures for 13 14 investigating a report of abuse and neglect of children living in a large group environment. The department shall review: 15 (1) the effect of removing children from the home as 16 opposed to removing the alleged perpetrator; 17 (2) the staffing requirements for removing a large 18 number of children at one time, including the needs for child 19 protective services caseworkers, law enforcement officers, and 20 21 substitute care providers; and 22 (3) the policies relating to interagency cooperation 23 that apply to investigations of abuse and neglect. The Department of Family and Protective Services shall 24 (b)

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1 report the results of the study to the lieutenant governor, the 2 speaker of the house of representatives, and the standing committee 3 of each house of the legislature with primary jurisdiction over 4 child abuse and neglect issues. The report must include any 5 recommendations for legislation.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
