- 2 relating to idling the diesel engine of a school bus while the bus
- 3 is parked at a public school or school event.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 34, Education Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 34.0041 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 34.0041. IDLING BUS DIESEL ENGINE AT SCHOOL OR SCHOOL
- 8 EVENT PROHIBITED. (a) In this section, "idling" means allowing an
- 9 engine to run while the motor vehicle is not engaged in forward or
- 10 reverse motion.
- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the driver of a
- 12 school bus equipped with a diesel engine may not allow the idling of
- 13 the bus engine while the bus is parked at a school or school event.
- 14 (c) Subsection (b) does not prohibit the idling of a school
- 15 bus diesel engine:
- 16 (1) for the minimum time necessary to heat or cool the
- 17 bus before departure, provided that the engine is turned off when a
- 18 student is embarking or disembarking; or
- 19 (2) as necessary to accommodate the physical needs of
- 20 <u>a student who receives special education services, regardless of</u>
- 21 whether students are embarking or disembarking.
- SECTION 2. Section 34.0041, Education Code, as added by
- 23 this Act, applies beginning with the 2009-2010 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
