5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 55, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 55.17522 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 55.17522. THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS SYSTEM; ADDITIONAL
8	BONDS. (a) In addition to the other authority granted by this
9	subchapter, the board of regents of The University of Texas System
10	may acquire, purchase, construct, improve, renovate, enlarge, or
11	equip property, buildings, structures, or other facilities,
12	including roads and related infrastructure, for projects at The
13	University of Texas - Pan American, to be financed by the issuance
14	of bonds in accordance with this subchapter and in accordance with a
15	systemwide revenue financing program adopted by the board not to
16	exceed the following aggregate principal amounts for the projects
17	<pre>specified as follows:</pre>
18	(1) \$1.5 million for the Starr County Upper Level Center;
19	<u>and</u>
20	(2) \$29,954,000 for the fine arts academic and performance
21	<pre>complex.</pre>
22	(b) The board may pledge irrevocably to the payment of bonds
23	authorized by Subsection (a) all or any part of the revenue funds of
24	an institution, branch, or entity of The University of Texas

- 1 System, including student tuition charges. The amount of a pledge
- 2 made under this subsection may not be reduced or abrogated while the
- 3 bonds for which the pledge is made, or bonds issued to refund those
- 4 bonds, are outstanding.
- 5 (c) If sufficient funds are not available to the board to
- 6 meet its obligations under this section, the board may transfer
- 7 funds among institutions, branches, and entities of The University
- 8 of Texas System to ensure the most equitable and efficient
- 9 allocation of available resources for each institution, branch, or
- 10 entity to carry out its duties and purposes.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
