1 (iii) copper; a felony of the third degree if the value of the 2 (5) property stolen is \$20,000 or more but less than \$100,000, or the 3 property is: 4 10 or more head of cattle, horses, or exotic 5 (A) 6 livestock or exotic fowl as defined by Section 142.001, Agriculture Code, stolen during a single transaction and having an aggregate 7 8 value of less than \$100,000; or 100 or more head of sheep, swine, or goats 9 (B) 10 stolen during a single transaction and having an aggregate value of less than \$100,000; 11 a felony of the second degree if the value of the 12 (6) property stolen is \$100,000 or more but less than \$200,000; or 13 a felony of the first degree if the value of the 14 (7)15 property stolen is \$200,000 or more. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009. 20
