## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the authority of certain counties to regulate the
3	location of wind energy electric generating facilities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 234, Local Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Subchapter C to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER C. REGULATION OF WIND ENERGY ELECTRIC GENERATING
8	<u>FACILITIES</u>
9	Sec. 234.061. SCOPE OF REGULATORY AUTHORITY. (a) The
10	commissioners court of a county to which this subchapter applies by
11	order may regulate the construction of wind energy electric
12	generating facilities in the unincorporated area of the county by:
13	(1) prohibiting the location of a facility in all or
14	part of the county;
15	(2) restricting the location of a facility by
16	requiring a buffer zone so that the facility is located at least:
17	(A) one mile from a habitable structure;
18	(B) one-half mile from property lines; and
19	(C) 10 miles from a federal or state natural area
20	or park; or
21	(3) restricting the location of a facility within the
22	county by establishing other requirements.
23	(b) Subsection (a) does not authorize a county to adopt
24	zoning regulations.

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- 1 Sec. 234.062. APPLICATION OF REGULATORY AUTHORITY. This
- 2 subchapter applies only to a county through which the Brazos River
- 3 flows and that has a population of at least 25,000 but fewer than
- 4 40,000.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
