- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1952.056, Insurance Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1952.056. REQUIRED PROVISION: COVERAGE FOR CERTAIN
- 8 SPOUSES AND FAMILY MEMBERS. A personal automobile insurance policy
- 9 or any similar policy form adopted or approved by the commissioner
- 10 under Article 5.06 or filed under Subchapter B, Chapter 2301, that
- 11 covers liability arising out of ownership, maintenance, or use of a
- 12 motor vehicle shall:

- (a) provide continuing coverage for a spouse during a period
- 14 of separation in contemplation of divorce; and
- 15 (b) not exclude from coverage any other family member of the
- 16 insured, including any person who is related by blood, adoption or
- 17 marriage and who resides in the named insured's household. [of a
- 18 spouse who is otherwise insured by the policy must contain a
- 19 provision to continue coverage for the spouse during a period of

- 21 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an action commenced on
- 22 or after the effective date of this Act. An action that is
- 23 commenced before the effective date of this Act is governed by the

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
